- 1. This is a Mixed Scotch Doubles Handicap Tournament. There will be no TEAM MAXIMUM. Individual method of handicap will be 100% of 220. Professional bowlers may not bowl together. All games will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
- 2. **ADULTS & YOUTH:** Entrants will use their highest 2023-2024 Yearbook average. If you do not have a 2023-2024 book average, use your 2022-2023 yearbook average. If you do not have either of these, you may use a current league average (minimum 12 games) with presentation of current league standing sheet.
- 3. **ADULTS**: In the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> games, the Lady will throw the first ball with the Gentleman throwing for the spare. If she strikes, then the Gentleman will throw the first ball in the next frame until he gets a strike. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> game the Gentleman will throw the first ball, and the Lady will be going for the spare. If the Gentleman throws a strike on the first ball, the Lady will throw the first ball in the following frame and every frame thereafter until that bowler gets a strike.

**YOUTH**: Teams may consist of several options: Male/Female, Male/Male, or Female/Female. In the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> games, the lower average bowler will throw the first ball with the higher average throwing for the spare. If the lower average bowler strikes, the higher average bowler will throw the first ball with the lower average bowler throwing for the spare until that bowler gets a strike. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> game, the higher average bowler will throw the first ball with the lower average bowler throwing for the spare. If the higher average bowler throws a strike on the first ball, the lower average bowler will throw the first ball in the following frame, and every frame thereafter until that bowler gets a strike.

- 4. **ADULTS**: Within 30 days, checks will be mailed to the winners. Prize money will be returned 100% paying 1 in 10 entries. A person may only cash once with the same partner. In case of a tie for any position, prize monies will be combined and divided equally.
  - **YOUTH**: First Place finishers will receive medallions. In case of a tie, duplicate awards will be presented. 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place awards will be determined by number of entries. All awards will be presented during the winner's youth leagues. Any remaining funds will be donated to the Lake City VA Medical Center. Youth dress code will prevail.
- 5. No confirmation will be sent. If your preferred time is unavailable, you will be contacted. Entries wishing to bowl together should be sent in together.
- 6. Bowlers are responsible for submitting their correct averages. If correctly submitted, bowlers will be disqualified.
